NOTE: The distinguished plan choice includes the following additional requirements:

1. An additional year of foreign language (3 years of the same language)
2. Four Advanced Measures obtainable as follows:
 - a) PSAT commended score (Junior year) earns 1 Adv Measure
 - b) AP tests score of 3 or above earns 1 Adv Measure per test score
Advance Placement course work requires a student to perform at the college level in that given course as preparation for taking the AP test for such course. Test scores required to obtain credit at institutions of higher learning VARY. Earning an advanced measure for a "3" on an AP test, does not guarantee the college of your choice will accept this score for awarding credit. You must check individual college policies.
 - c) Dual credit college course work with a grade of "A or B" earns 1 Adv Measure per semester
This course work can award you dual (both high school & college) credit for the course taken. Research shows wide transferability of this coursework, however, you should ALWAYS CHECK with the college of your choice to confirm.
